## Pony Of the Americas Club Inc. National Family of the Year Nomination Form

Every organization is unique in some way. The Pony of the Americas Club Inc. is unique among horse organizations because of the special relationship it enjoys with its families. The purpose of this award is to recognize and honor an individual POA family each year. By annually awarding a POA family, our organization formally recognizes the contributions that families make to the success of the POA breed.

This official application must be submitted by a State Club or Chapter only. Only one family per year may be nominated by each State Club or Chapter. This form must be typed or neatly printed and all parts of this form including any essays and letters must be submitted in the same packet to the National POAC. All Nomination Forms become the property of the POAC. It is suggested that at least one member of the selected family be able to attend the annual POAC National Convention in February to receive their award. A review panel will look at the applications and report the final results to POAC CEO. Each application will be reviewed on its own merits and an award will be presented only if the panel finds a qualified application.



## Nominated Family Statement

- B. The nominated family should complete a resume form and include a typed statement of 500 words or less in response to "How the POA Organization has influenced or benefited our family". This may include some or all of the following components: building self-esteem, confidence, responsibility, strengthening family relationships, nurturing friendships and/or experiences/adventures shared by a family as a result of their involvement in the POAC. This award is NOT to be influenced nor based upon winnings or competitive accomplishments. It is preferred that you not include this area of involvement except in general terms. The following items should be answered in this Family Statement:
- List other horse related organizations and/or functions which your family has shown or promoted POAs.
- · List awards/acknowledgements or other formal recognition received from state/national POA Clubs (scholarships, sportsmanship awards, etc.). Do not include competitive winnings.
- · List the levels of POA show participation at state/national levels (Regional, Classic, World, Congress, etc.)
- List POA leadership positions held by immediate family members at state/national levels (board membership, offices held, committees, etc.)

Reminder: All state club letters, family letters and resume information need to be given to the state club/chapter president or designee to be sent in as one packet to the National POAC.
