- High Point Awards will be presented Saturday, July 20, 2019 at the conclusion of the daily events.

If you win a high point award and will not be at the Awards Presentation you need to make arrangements for the award to be picked up. If the National POAC has to ship your award(s) to you after the show, you will be billed postage.

- High Point & Res. Jr. Pony Award-Halter (handler must be 18&U), Jr WP, Jr HUS, Jr Trail, & Jr Rein.
- High Point & Res. Sr. Pony Award- Halter (handler must be 18&U), Sr WP, Sr HUS, Sr Trail, & Sr Rein.
- High Point & Res. JPFC 2 Yr Old - JPFC WP, HUS, & Trail
- High Point & Res. JPFC 3 Yr Old - JPFC WP, HUS, & Trail
- High Point & Res. JPFC 4&5 Yr Olds - JPFC WP, HUS, & Trail
- High Point & Res. In-Hand Yearling Triad - Halter, LL, & Trail
- High Point & Res. In-Hand 2 Yr Old Triad - Halter, LL, & Trail
- High Point & Res. 19&O - All 19&O classes count for award

- High Point & Res. 45&O - All 45&O classes count for award as well as 19&O Reining & Ranch Riding
 - High Point & Res. Non-Pro w/t – All Non-Pro w/t classes count for award plus Non-Pro SMS
 - High Point & Res. Non-Pro w/t/c – All Non-Pro w/t/c classes count for award plus Non-Pro SMS
 - High Point & Res. Novice Rider 18&U w/j/l - All novice 18&U w/j/l classes count for award
 - High Point & Res. W/T Rider 18&U - All 18&U w/t classes count for award
- ***The Mandatory Congress Show High Points can be found in the handbook pg.71 rule 66.***
 - ***Pleasure Driving, Most Colorful, Hunter In-Hand, and YOUTH Halter DO NOT count for high points.***
 - ***ANY YOUTH AND ADULT EXHIBITORS RIDING THE SAME PONY MUST FILL OUT A POINT DESIGNATION PRIOR TO THE SHOW***
 - ***ANY PONY BEING RIDDEN IN THE SAME EVENT TYPE MUST HAVE A DESIGNATION FORM FILLED OUT PRIOR TO THE SHOW***
 - ***ANY NEW PONY/RIDER COMBINATIONS ASSIGNED A NUMBER AFTER THE SHOW HAS STARTED WILL NOT QUALIFY TOWARDS HIGH POINTS***
 - ***ANY 19&O RIDER SHOWING IN BOTH 19&O AND 45&O MUST FILL OUT A FORM TO DESIGNATE WHICH HIGH POINT DIVISION THEY ARE SHOWING FOR PRIOR TO THE SHOW***
 - ***9&U WALK/TROT PLEASURE CLASSES DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS HIGH POINT***

Class and Show Rules

- ***In all classes requiring an order of go or classes requiring cuts will have those orders and cuts posted no later than the morning of that day's events. If you miss your turn in the order of go or your posted cut without a direct class conflict and without notifying the gate personnel/show management, you WILL NOT be allowed to participate in that class.***
- ***SPORTSMANSHIP POLICY*** – Any person acting or inciting or permitting any other to act in a manner contrary to the Rules of the POAC or in a manner deemed unsportsmanlike, improper, unethical, dishonest, intemperate or prejudicial to the best interests of the POAC shall be reported to the POAC and subject to disciplinary procedures.
- ***HEALTH OF EQUINE ENTRIES*** - All equine entering the grounds and/or show are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health paper) from a licensed accredited veterinarian dated within 30 days of arrival and an Equine Infectious Anemia test (Coggins) performed within the last 12 months.
- ***9&U*** – Youth cannot cross enter in w/j and w/j/l classes.
- ***NOVICE*** – Any youth participating in Novice Classes must complete the Novice Agreement Form.
- ***NON-PRO*** – Any adult participating in Non-Pro must possess a Non-Pro Card issued from the National Office. An application must be filled out and sent in. Please allow 2-3 weeks for this process.
- ***19&O/45&O*** – These divisions can be cross entered for the reason that the 45&O division WILL NOT receive year end National points. If you are eligible and choose to show in both divisions, you must claim the High Point you are showing for prior to the show.
- ***BREEDER CLASSES*** – Mare & Foal, Get of Sire, and Produce of Dam require an additional entry form that must be completed at the Show Office when entering the class(es). Post entries are permitted for these classes without additional fees. Entry Forms must be completed, paid for, and turned in before class 99.
